Position Summary: This position serves as a Floater Assistant Teacher for the Early Head Start program. The Floater Assistant Teacher will work collaboratively with the Teacher to ensure the successful operation of a classroom of children. The Floater Assistant Teacher also works with a team of other classroom Assistant Teachers and family members to implement curriculum to achieve outcomes for children of all abilities. The Floater Assistant Teacher will ultimately be evaluated on a combination of skills, dispositions and behaviors, some of which are related to the specific service area of this position and others that represent general expectations of all employees.

Qualifications/Experience:

- ➤ High School diploma or its equivalent;
- Must hold up to date Child Development Associate (CDA) credential, for infant and toddler:
- Associate or Bachelor's degree in Early Childhood education preferred;
- Experience working with children ages 0-3 years;
- ➤ Must have valid driver's license;
- Must pass physical examination, background check and driving record in compliance with State and Federal regulations;
- ➤ Obtain certification in CPR/First Aid, Shaken Baby Syndrome and Sudden Infant Death Syndrome.
- ➤ Obtain clear Tuberculosis test before hire and every two years thereafter.

Responsibilities:

Ensure daily morning and afternoon breaks to all class rooms teachers.

- > Comply with and implement all applicable local, state and federal regulations;
- ➤ Maintain a working relationship with other classroom and/or support staff and with the public;
- Assist teachers in all aspects of the classroom operation including carrying out lesson plans and daily activities;
- ➤ Create, support and maintain a healthy, safe, learning environment conducive to each child's intellectual, physical, social, emotional, and aesthetic development;
- Actively teach, model and engage children in play and learning in classroom;
- > Establish and maintain a positive and trusting relationship with children and their families:
- ➤ Maintain accurate records for each child, data entry and completion of appropriate documents and referrals as needed in a timely manner;
- Actively supervise and engage children at all times to ensure child safety;
- Maintain confidentiality of all children, family and informational records;
- Assist in the process of classroom coverage. Punctuality is critical;
- ➤ Must learn and execute emergency preparedness plan and be responsive to emergencies that may arise;
- Work with children and their families to support development toward school readiness;
- ➤ Maintain accurate daily records on attendance, daily intake, medical log, preschooler information for distribution in child file and to parents as well as other required forms;
- Maintain and document all contacts with parents. Develop and maintain a professional relationship with parents of enrolled children;
- Attend training and conferences as requested by the supervisor;
- ➤ Work cooperatively as a team with the Education manager and other educational staff to plan, coordinate and implement the educational plans;
- Maintain a neat, orderly and safe classroom environment, making timely reports to management with health and safety concerns;
- > Physically be able to lift at least 40lbs. and sit on floor with children;
- ➤ Maintain teacher child ratio:
- > Perform all other duties as assigned.
